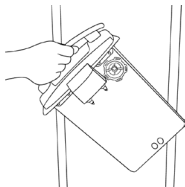
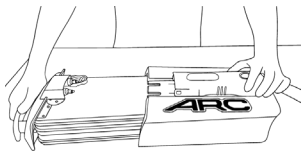


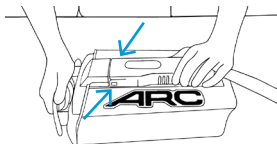
1. After 4 hours, remove
CryoCore from freezer



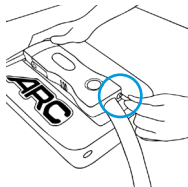
2. Insert CryoCore into
insulation case



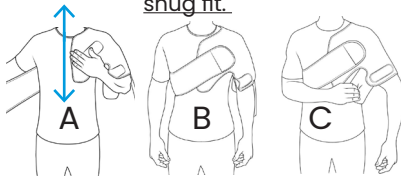
3. Connect controller by

both tabs click



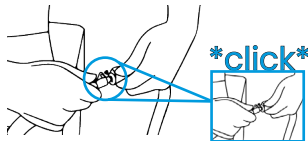
4. Connect power supply.



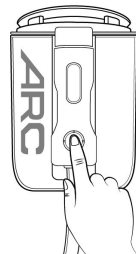
5. Attach shoulder therapy wrap
